COVID-19 PREPAREDNESS PLAN – Gull Lake Frozen Fore

In order to move forward with planning an in-person fundraising event it is important to stay abreast to the current COVID-19 Regulations.

Considering this, we have put in place the following action steps for the February 20, 2021 Gull Lake Frozen Fore Event.

Bussing:

- 50% capacity will be adhered on all bus transportation (40 persons)
- Busses will run 11a-6p; each will stay at one location for 30 minutes – then have 15 minutes of travel time to next location.
- Each participant will stay on the same bus for the duration of day.

Capacity / Logistics:

In order to launch tickets sales, All MN & CDC guidelines will be followed including (but not limited to):

- Masks will be required to be worn while participants are indoor / public spaces.
- Limiting ticket sales to 50% capacity of each space being used at event
 - o Participants will be asked to sign up for a one (of 10) starting locations – each location will be limited to 40 persons at one time.
- Social distancing of six feet whenever possible.
- Using one entrance and one exit for all indoor spaces
- Participants will be required to register online; scorecards (tickets) will be at starting locations in one designated pick up area.

Other:

- The Gull Lake Events team recognizes procedures and protocols are subject to change and will adhere to ALL MN COVID-19 mandates in place on day of events.
- Event will be a ONE day event; eliminating any night activities such as live music in tents as well as a food event on Sunday.
- The Frozen Flop portion of the event will be moved outdoors and held during the day on Saturday, February 20 with designated timeslots with no more than six participants at each timeslot.
